



Instrument Pilot

Objective: The Instrument pilot program is designed to assist the student in obtaining their instrument pilot license.

The instrument Pilot License allows a Pilot to fly by Instrument Flight Rules (IFR), a limit of passengers and share the cost of use of the plane. Not for hire, subject to Federal Aviation Reg 61.113.

Prerequisites: PPL license, 25 hours of cross-country PIC time, and as per FAR/AIM

Phase 1 – Instrument Pilot License

During this phase the student attains their instrument pilot license. This phase includes 40 hours total flight time and up to 24 hours of ground instruction time.

This program includes a total of:

1. Flight time-----40 hours
2. Flight Instruction-----40 hours
3. Ground Instruction-----24 hours

Any accrued hours above the listed amount will be charged a per hour rate, and due at the time of service

1. Payment

- a. The cost of this program is \$14,250.
- b. Prepayment discount \$250
- c. Four payment option
 - i. 25% prior to beginning lesson
 - ii. 25% at 10 hours of flight time
 - iii. 25% at 20 Hours of flight time
 - iv. 25% at 30 hours of flight time
- d. Late payments
 - i. All past due accounts will incur a finance charge in the amount of 1.75% of the balance due per month (21 percent per annum). All checks returned for “Insufficient Funds” will

incur a service charge in the amount of \$40.00 per check in addition to the cost of services rendered and any charges by their bank

e. Refunds

i. BRAG does not issue refunds for any unused portion of flight training
